

SAFE CHEWS FOR DOGS

It's sometimes hard to know what is safe or unsafe for your dog to chew.

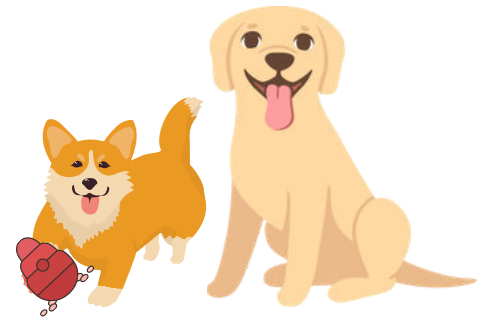
When picking a chew, remember:

- Bones, (raw or cooked), antlers, and Yak Chews can be dangerous for your dog to consume
- Bully sticks should be offered with caution

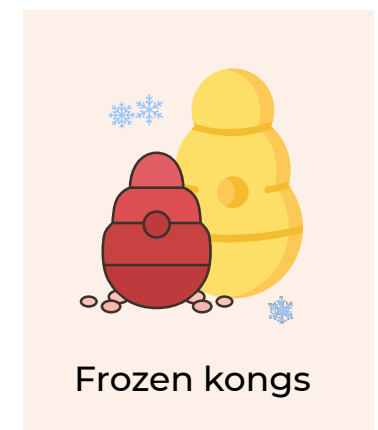
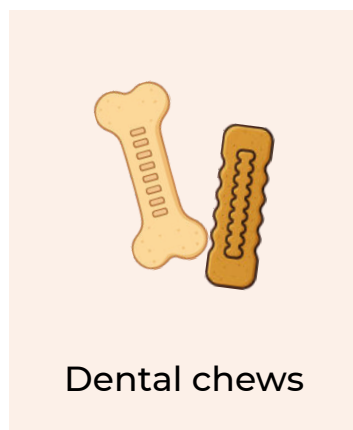
They can cause:

- Choking
- Injuries to the mouth and tongue
- Damage to the stomach and intestinal tract (small fragments), leading to serious and sometimes fatal infections
- Broken teeth

Fortunately, there are safer treat alternatives that ensure your dog can still get the enrichment of a fun treat without the danger.



Instead of bones, try giving your dog:



Here's a good rule of thumb: if you hit yourself with it on the knee and it hurts, then don't give it to your dog! In other words, if it hurts your bones, it could also hurt their teeth.
